RPRA is seeking an experienced and collaborative professional to join the organization as a Salesforce Developer. As a Salesforce Developer, you will work in an agile development environment as part of a team (in-house and outsourced) to implement and customize our Salesforce system.

Practically speaking, you will:

- Work as a member of the team at every stage of software development life cycle solution design, development, unit testing, system testing, test automation, documentation, training and deployment
- Able to research and learn new methodologies and technologies and bring knowledge to the team
- Provide input and influence discussions around best practices and new technologies, helping us to develop an effective basis for future developments
- Define and understand requirements relating to Salesforce capabilities
- Design and develop solutions with multiple components of the Salesforce Platform (including Service Cloud, Marketing Cloud and Experience Cloud)
- Design, develop, test, release, and maintain complex workflow rules, validation rules, formulas, custom workflow, process builder, page layouts, custom fields/objects, and other Salesforce customizations.
- Create screen mock-ups using tools like Figma based on business requirements.
- Write clear and concise technical solution approach documentation in JIRA and Confluence
- Perform coding and development in salesforce using compliance security measures which include but limited to application and data security as defined under salesforce quidelines

- Responsible for delivery of custom developments and ensure that the code developed is technically sound and scalable
- Responsible for delivery of Data Migration from different sources into Salesforce
- Responsible for delivery of integrating Salesforce with Dell Boomi, SAP, External API, Twillio, Chargent, Amazon Connect and Mobile App
- Responsible to work with business to seek approval on requirements, User Acceptance Test
- Responsible for implementing approved changes into Salesforce production environment getting all necessary approvals from business stakeholders
